Per feedback, the said facility does not appear on their records. SWO-I VAW also went to Dr. Gonzales' clinic, but there was no one present.
				With this, RRPTP Focal Person contacted the Regional WCPD likewise conferred the case to the Standards Unit for assistance. Planned visit will be made to assess the status of the facility.

									September 9, 2014  A call from Ms. Eva Gregorio of MSWDO Naga City inquiring on the assistance being provided by the DSWD to victims of trafficking after an entrapment operation undertaken by the CIDG-Camarines Sur.  Accordingly, a case was already filed in court and the female victims decided to return to their homes.  Technical assistance was provided yet, to address further concerns such the creation of LCAT, a dialogue was carried out on September 19, 2014. Ms. Gregorio received a packet comprising documents needed to for the provision of RRPTP services.
