We are respectfully submitting the Supplementary Feeding Program Report for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2014.

## Supplementary Feeding Program in Day Care Centers

- For the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, Field Office is still on the process of reviewing data and submitted documents of LGUs from Region to complete the Report on Nutritional Status for CY 2013-2014 and the Report on Baseline Weight Data of Day Care Children from Region V that is being requested by the Central Office. The Report on Baseline Weight is already transmitted to Central Office as of today September 23, 2014.
- As of this date, we have already a total of 139,677 day care children beneficiaries from 4,277 day care centers or 83 LGUs for Region V funded for 4th cycle implementation. For the 83 LGUs, 66 LGUs with 87,145 children in 2,711 day care centers have already started the feeding and other complimentary activities. For the remaining 17 LGUs whose checks has not yet been released, the Field Office already coordinated with C/MSWDO of concerned LGUs to get the checks so as not to hamper the activities of SFP.

## Supplementary Feeding Program in partnership with Department of Education

With regards to the School-Based Feeding Program, the check amounting to Php 65,965,440.00 was already transferred to Department of Education Region V last September 8, 2014. It is intended to cater 34,357 severely wasted children in 1,028 public elementary schools to rehabilitate 70% of the severely wasted beneficiaries to normal Nutritional Status at the end of 120 days feeding. The regional launching was held last September 16, 2014 at Tabaco Central School in Panal, Tabaco City.

## Other Activities Conducted:

Last August 7-9, 2014, the 40th Foundation Day and Nutrition Summit with the Theme: "PYAP Maabilidad! Kalamidad Paghandaan: Gutom at Malnutrisyon Agapan" was held at the Kawa-kawa Hill, Tuburan, Ligao City. It was participated by 112 out-of-school-youths and youth service providers from 22 Municipalities in Region. The objective of the activity is to disseminate and impart knowledge regarding proper nutrition and disaster preparedness. The participants were oriented on proper nutrition, basic life support, disaster preparedness and response. Other activities during the summit were poster making contest, slogan writing, Nutri Quiz, Lakan at Lakambini ng PYAP and Nutrition Idol.
