INVITATION TO BID

Board and Lodging for the Training Workshop on Establishing Pantawid Case Referral Pathways for Women, Children and Families in Especially Difficult Circumstances – Lot 1

1. The Department of Social Welfare and Development, Field Office V, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) intends to apply the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Pesos (P352,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for IB No. GOP/19-DSWD-06. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The Department of Social Welfare and Development, Field Office V now invites bids for the furnish of Board and Lodging for the Training Workshop on Establishing Pantawid Case Referral Pathways for Women, Children and Families in Especially Difficult Circumstances – Lot 1. Delivery of the Goods is required per approved final schedule. Bidders should have completed, within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from Department of Social Welfare and Development, FO V and

inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 8:00AM to 5:00PM.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on February 26, 2019 from the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of: Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00)

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before 1:30 P.M., March 11, 2019. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

Bid opening shall be on March 11, 2019, 1:30 P.M. at DSWD FO V. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

7. The Department of Social Welfare and Development, FO V reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
