Special Provision(s)

1. Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program. The amount of One Hundred Six Billion Eight Hundred Million Five Hundred Sixty Wine Thousand Pesos (P106,800,569,000) appropriated herein for the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) shall be used to support the poverty reduction and social development strategy of the National Government, composed of:

The 4Ps shall cover the following beneficiaries, as determined by the DSWD: (i) those registered in the Mational Household Targeting System for Poverty Reduction (MHTS-PR); (ii) victims of natural and man-made disasters rendered homeless and with no means of livelihood; (iii) indigenous peoples in GIDAs; (iv) homeless street families; and (v) household beneficiaries of 4Ps, whose level of well-being have improved but still at high risk of subsequently falling back into survival level as they precariously live with little or no buffer against economic shocks. To ensure the consistent use of relevant statistical information, the MHTS-PR shall be shared with the PSA.

The above-mentioned beneficiaries who are compliant to program conditions shall continue to receive educational and health grants under Pantawid Pamilya and other social protection programs such as, but not limited to, livelihood assistance and health services through Philhealth.

The DSMD shall provide beneficiaries direct and secured access to cash grants through an authorized government depository bank (AGDB). In case there is no AGDB in the locality, the DSWD may enter into contracts with rural banks, thrift banks, cooperative banks, and institutions engaged in money remittances duly accredited by the BSP.

- 2. Rice Subsidy. The amount of Twenty Mine Billion Three Hundred Forty Six Million Six Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand Pesos (P29,346,667,000) appropriated herein under the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program shall be used for the provision of Rice Subsidy amounting to Six Hundred pesos (P600) a month in the form of financial assistance to the qualified 4Ps beneficiaries. However, when the price of palay drops to a critical level as determined and recommended by the Department of Agriculture, Department of Finance, and Mational Economic and Development Authority, the DSMD may enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Mational Food Authority (NFA) for the purchase of rice for the distribution to the 4Ps beneficiaries: PROVIDED, That in areas where there are no NFA offices or warehouses, or in isolated or hard-to-reach areas, the DSMD may enter into a MOA with the LGU or accredited farmers' organization for the same purpose. The MOA shall clearly stipulate the mechanisms for the distribution of rice, as well as the monitoring of the beneficiaries. The six hundred pesos (P600) a month shall also cover all administrative costs in the procurement and distribution of the twenty (20) kilos of rice per beneficiary. (CONDITIONAL IMPLEMENTATION President's Veto Message, December 28, 2020, Volume I-B, page 848, R.A. No. 11518)
- 3. Protective Services Program. The amount appropriated herein for protective services for individuals, families and communities in difficult circumstances shall be used to carry-out the alternative family care program and to implement and to provide financial assistance to individuals, families and communities in difficult situations. This includes food assistance, food packs, transportation, medical, burial assistance, assistance to students, cash/food for work, and all other types of assistance to individuals/sectors/communities in especially difficult circumstances who are vulnerable, at risk, or affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and/or disastrous calamities.

The DSMD shall post the following on its official websites: (i) list of cases responded to and the type of intervention provided; and (ii) list of program-beneficiaries, their locations, the specific assistance given to them and the corresponding amounts, subject to the provisions of R.A. No. 10173 or the "Data Privacy Act of 2012". The Secretary of Social Welfare and Development and the agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said reports are posted on the official website of the DSMD, which shall be considered compliance with the said reportorial requirements.

Implementation of this provision shall be subject to quidalines as may be issued for this purpose.

4. Social Pension for Indigent Senior Citizens. The amount of Twenty Three Billion Four Hundred Fifty Eight Million Two Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand Pesos (P23,458,267,000) appropriated herein for the social pension of indigent senior citizens shall be used for the monthly stipend of Five Hundred Pesos (P500) to senior citizen-beneficiaries, as determined by the DSMD. In no case shall more than seven percent (7%) of said amount be used for administrative expenses.

The DSMD shall ensure that the stipend shall be given directly to senior citizen-beneficiaries. In case the senior citizen-beneficiaries are not capable of personally receiving the stipend for health or safety reasons, as verified by the DSMD, it may engage the services of money remittance companies duly accredited by the BSP and other secure means of money remittance as determined by the DSMD.

- 5. Supplementary Feeding Program. The amount of Three Billion Eight Hundred Thirty Million Four Hundred Sixteen Thousand Pesos (P3,830,416,000) appropriated herein for supplementary feeding program shall be used to implement the supplementary feeding for children within the ages two (2) to four (4) and children under five (5) years of age, who are not yer formally enrolled in kindergarten schools using the community-based procurement system. The feeding program shall be administered in the child development center, daycare center, or in any other appropriate facility. Priority shall be given to children in fourth, fifth, and sixth class municipalities and in areas with large population of undernourished children. In order to provide complete nutrition for program beneficiaries, the DSMD shall coordinate with the Department of Health, the National Nutrition Council, the Department of Agriculture, the Early Childhood Care and Development Council and other concerned departments/agencies for the incorporation of therapeutic milk and other protein-, vitamin-, and mineral-enriched foods in the fortified meals.

- 6. Social Protection Program for Teen-Aged Nothers and their Children. In consultation with the Commission on Population and Development, the DSWD shall develop a social protection program specifically for teen-aged mothers who are minors and their children.
- 7. Social Protection Program for Fisherfolk and their Families Affected by Calamities and Closed Periods of Fishing. In consultation with the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR), the DSMD shall develop a social protection system, including income-support or social protection system for fisherfolk and their families whose livelihoods are affected during periods of closed seasons for fishing declared by BFAR and also during periods of inclement weather when small crafts are prevented from going out to
- 8. Trust Receipts from the Proceeds from the Sale of the Welfareville Property. Proceeds derived from the sale of the Welfareville Property, net of lawful expenses, including the cost of relocation of the National Center for Mental Health, Center for Health Development-National Capital Region, and DOJ Correctional Institution for Women shall be used to promote the welfare of indigent children, constituted as the Children's Welfare and Development Fund in accordance with R.A. Ho. 5260. Said proceeds shall be deposited with the National Treasury in accordance with E.O. No. 338, s. 1996 and shall be recorded as trust receipts.

GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, FY 2021

- 9. Quick Response Fund. The amount of One Billion Two Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P1,250,000,000) appropriated herein for the Quick Response Fund (QRF) shall serve as a stand-by fund to be used for rehabilitation and relief programs, including the prepositioning of goods and equipment, in order that the situation and living conditions of people in communities or areas affected by natural or human-induced calamities, epidemics, crises, catastrophes which occured in the last quarter of the immediately preceding year and those occuring during the current year may be normalized as quickly as possible. In no case shall the QRF be used for pre-disaster activities, such as conduct of training, insurance of assets, and public information initiatives, or any other purpose not authorized in this Act.
- 10. PAyapa at MAsaganang PamayaMAn Program. The amount of Mine Hundred Sixty Million Mine Hundred Seventeen Thousand Pesos (P960,917,000) appropriated herein for the Payapa at Masaganang PamayaMan (PAMAMA) Program shall be used exclusively to implement projects in conflict-affected areas already identified by the OPAPP.

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.O. Mo. 292, s. 1987.

- 11. Reporting and Posting Requirements. The DSMD shall submit quarterly reports on its financial and physical accomplishments, within thirty (30) days after the end of every quarter, through the following:
- (a) URS or other electronic means for reports not covered by the URS until such time that all agencies have fully migrated to the BTMS; and
 - (b) DSWD's website.

PROGRAMS

- The DSMD shall send written notice when said reports have been submitted or posted on its mebsite to the DBM, House of Representatives, Senate of the Philippines, House Committee on Appropriations, Senate Committee on Finance, and other offices where the submission of reports is required under the existing laws, rules and regulations. The date of notice to said agencies shall be considered the date of compliance with this requirement.
- 12. Appropriations for Programs and Specific Activities. The amounts appropriated herein for the programs of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities or projects in the indicated amounts and conditions:
